Sirs.

Thank you for your letter dated 31st December 1987, which was received on January 11th 1988, unlike your previous letter that has not yet reached the Embassy.

About your inquiry, I would like to inform you that it is acceptable to the Embassy that a translation in English of an official document written in Korean Language be attached to an application for a visa provided that:

- * The said translation bears a certification by a licenced Public Translator
- * The original document is attached
- * The visa Application Form in use in the Embassy is duly completed with 3 photographs and the visa fee paid (1.428 yens)

You will find enclosed herewith a sample of the Embassy visa application form.

There is a honorary Consulate of Senegal located at Seoul, where you can get visa for Senegal. The adresse is following:
