Dear Mr. Kim:

Thank you for your letter of January 27, 1987 concerning English translation requirements in support of a visa petition submitted to the Immigration and Naturalization Service.

The Service has promulgated English translation requirements in Title 8 Code of Federal Regulations Section 103.2(b)(1) as follows:

"A foreign document must be accompanied by an English translation in accordance with the instructions on the application or petition form. The translator must certify that he/she is competent to translate and that the translation is accurate."

The Service office having jurisdiction over where the visa petition is filed will make the determination on qualifying English translations. Therefore, if you have any specific questions regarding this issue please contact our Immigration Office at the American Embassy in Seoul, Korea. I have forwarded a copy of your letter to the Officer-in-charge of our Seoul office to inform him of your interest in this matter.
